Dear Members,

Due to the war in Eretz Yisroel, we have delayed our annual Simchas Torah fundraising campaign. We did not want to overburden the Kehila with two simultaneous campaigns, given the existential threat to our brothers and sisters in Israel.

Nonetheless, we can no longer continue to operate the Shul for the balance of the 5784 year unless we fundraise for it.

Although expenses keep rising, the Shul continues to provide excellent service with a warm, safe, and loving environment that you are accustomed to receiving.

In addition, starting Jan. 1, the Shul will be required to pay an additional; \$3,300 / month rent in order to use the TAG facility on Shabbos for the coming year. This is in addition to the rental of the main facility, which is \$276,000 /yr. As you can see, the total rental is much more than what the entire membership dues bring in. This is besides salaries, utilities, kiddush etc.

We have not increased the membership dues for many years in order not to create an undue hardship on those who can not pay. The Shul does not turn people away from membership due to a lack of funds.

We are grateful to the few members who did contribute on Simchas Torah, but we now must turn to the bulk of our membership to generously contribute towards the Shul.

In order to alleviate the burden, the Rebbetzin and I will be taking a significant decrease in salary, without diminishing the work that we do for the Shul. In addition to our annual donation, this will be our additional contribution to the cause, which will be tens of thousands of dollars.

That being said, we still must reach our target goal of raising and collecting **\$250,000** by Sept. 1, 2024. Please contact me directly with your pledge and payment plan ASAP.

Mark Lasarow, our treasurer, will be happy to review the financials so you can see where the money is going, and to see that the Shul is very prudent in its expenditures.

Going forward, we do not want to be in a position which would require us to consider what services to cut out or, Chas V'Shalom, to close down the Shul.

For those of you who have not contributed in the past campaigns, we encourage you to consider doing so. For those of you have contributed in the past, we thank you for your loyalty, and ask that you not decrease your past contributions, and perhaps increase it.


